Every year, there are **18 million new confirmed cancer cases** and **9.5 million cancer deaths** worldwide.

Every year, in Mexico, there are **190 thousand new confirmed cancer cases** and over **83 thousand cancer deaths**.





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In July of 2017, the creation of the National Cancer Registry was approved by the Mexican Legislative Power, through an effort of the entire Mexican health sector.

The Registry is a strategic program of collection, investigation, classification, analysis, academic support and diffusion of oncological information in Mexico, with the goal of helping in the creation of public policies against cancer.

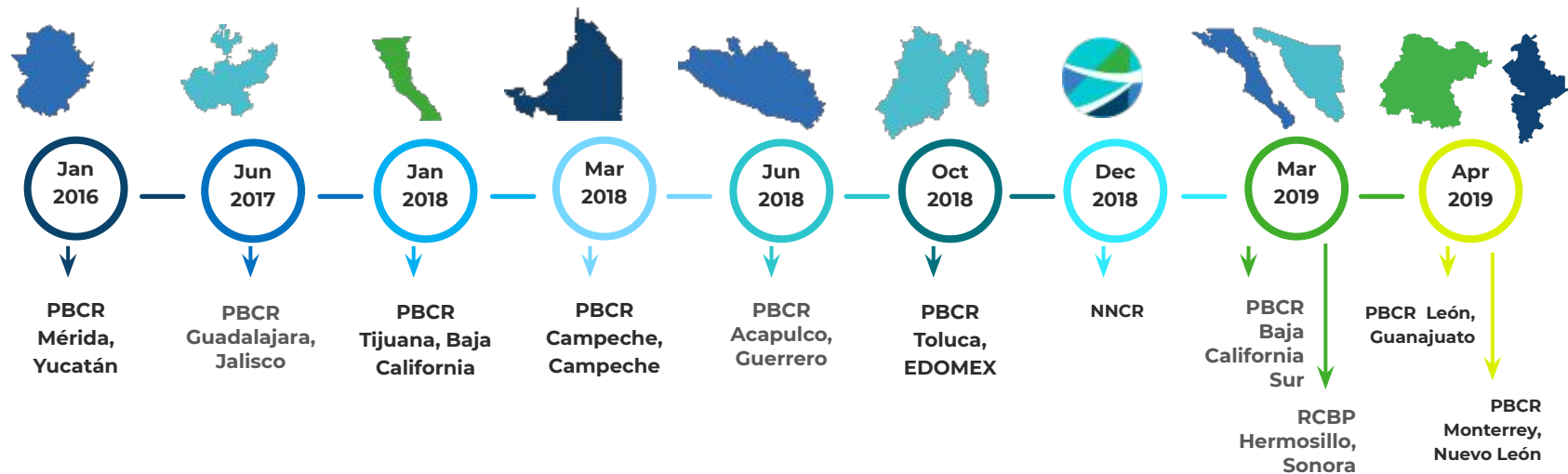


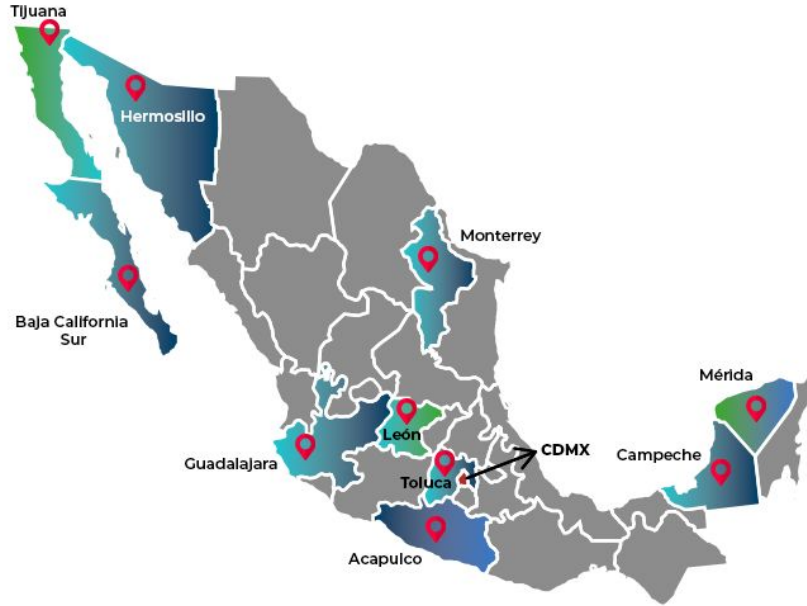
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Today, the National Cancer Registry is in **10 sentinel locations** that, together, form the National Network of Cancer Registries (NNCR).

Registry.



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The **registration forms** are created at the national level and consist of 29 standardized variables, according to national and international guidelines. They are divided into 5 sections.

There are **11 criteria** established by international health organizations (WHO, IARC, IACR and others) which ensure the quality of the information.
